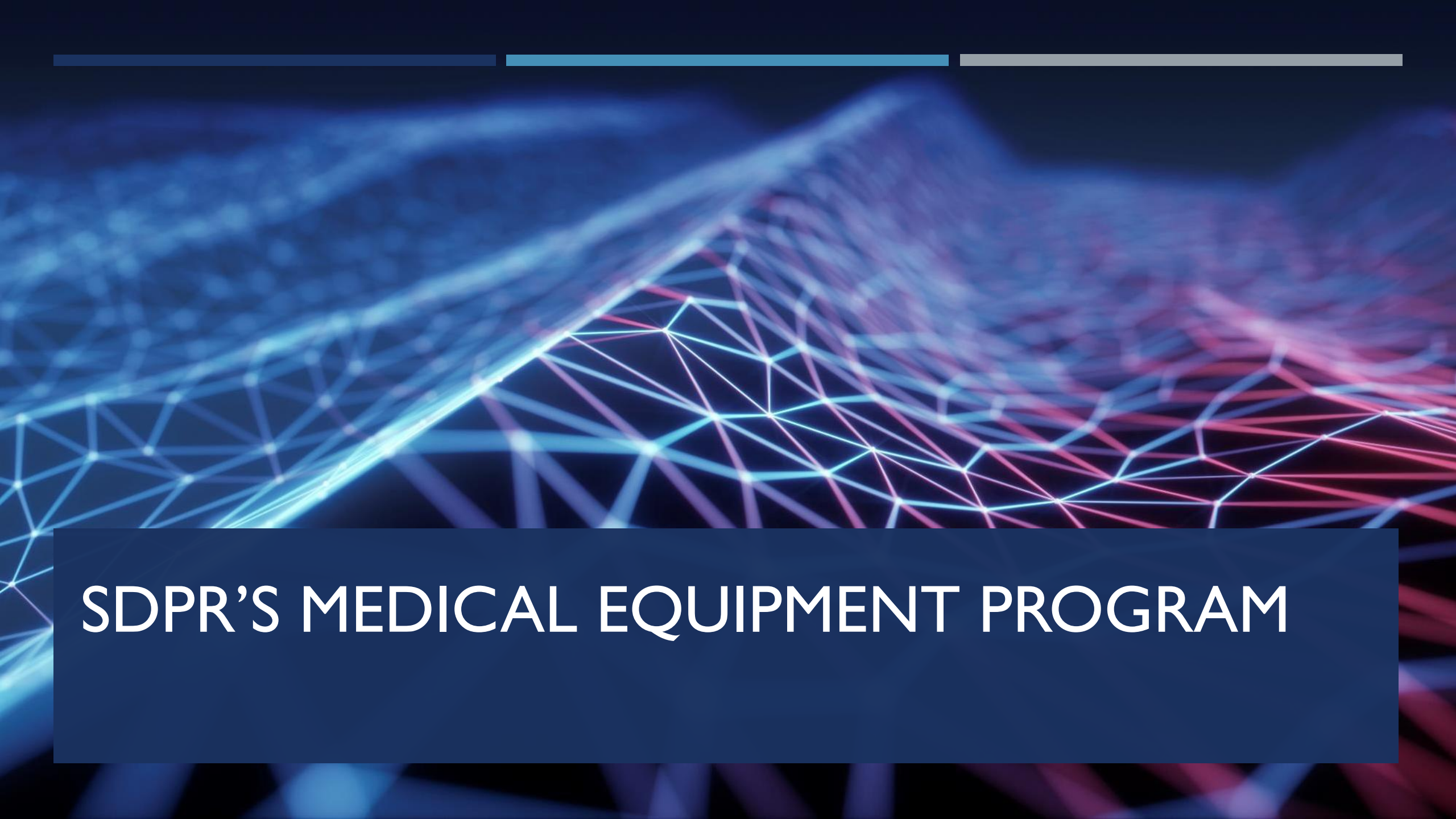

- Standard application procedures



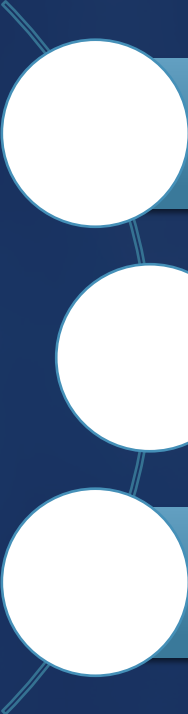
DOCUMENTATION

- Items **under \$750** require a Letter of Justification from an OT and/or a prescription from a physician and one quote from a contracted supplier.
- For items **over \$750** a Medical Equipment Request and Justification form is required HR2138
 - Section 1-Client information (to be completed by the Ministry). Includes client signature for release of information and agreement with equipment recommendation.
 - Section 2-Medical or Nurse Practitioner –medical condition of client and type of medical equipment recommended
 - Section 3-Assessment(OT) usually on letterhead and attached to HR2138
 - One quote from a contracted supplier

CRITERIA

- Pre-authorization required
- No other resources available
- Equipment must be the least expensive, appropriate
- Unable to replace equipment damaged through misuse (including lost or stolen)
- Equipment must be **medically essential**, directly related to a diagnosed condition, and providing a remedial benefit
- Mobility equipment must meet an impairment that limits client's day to day activities
- Eligible equipment categories defined by Regulations
